Applications are invited for the 2015/2016 Municipal Capital Works Program. The deadline for the receipt of applications for the 2015/2016 Municipal Capital Works Program is October 17, 2014.

The Department of Municipal and Intergovernmental Affairs will be utilizing the Provincial Government's online system MSIS (Municipal Support Information System), which has been developed for the submission of applications and project status reports. Applicants can access the application website at <a href="www.miga.gov.nl.ca">www.miga.gov.nl.ca</a>. To gain access to the online application site, Municipalities and Local Service Districts require a USER ID and PASSWORD. Any user whom has not obtained a USER ID and PASSWORD are asked to contact the Municipal & Intergovernmental Affairs System Administrator Eileen Cahill — <a href="mailto:mA-InfoMgmt@gov.nl.ca">MA-InfoMgmt@gov.nl.ca</a> or 1-709-729-5846.

Applicants please note that all applications that are on file from previous funding programs are no longer considered active and are being deleted from our databases. All applications <u>must</u> be entered through the MSIS System. It is not necessary for Municipalities, Inuit Community Governments or Local Service Districts to re-enter an application for a project that has already been approved. However, new applications are required to be submitted for phases of proposed projects not yet funded.

Applicants should only apply for projects which are affordable for their community as demonstrated by the completion of the <u>Financial Evaluation forms</u> available on the Department's website: <u>www.miga.gov.nl.ca</u>

The following items <u>must</u> be submitted in addition to the online application by the October 17, 2014 deadline. These items can be uploaded using the **Documents** section of the online application.

- Completed Financial Evaluation Form
- Resolution of Local Government authorizing the Application
- Project Cost Estimates
- Drawing indicating location and scope of the proposed project
