This circular is a reminder that the Municipal Infrastructure Division's 2023-2024 Call for Applications is now **open**. The application period was opened by circular on September 28, 2022; that circular is available at <https://www.gov.nl.ca/ti/mi/circulars/#c2022>. This will be MI's last application intake for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program. Applications for projects addressing Boil Water Advisories or compliance with federal Wastewater Systems Effluent Regulations are of particular interest to MI.

The deadline for applications is **October 28, 2022**. Late applications will not be considered. Applicants should upload their applications as soon as possible. In previous years, some applicants had encountered problems on the final submission day (i.e. power outages, internet access issues, etc.) resulting in applications missing the submission deadline.
