**Re:** **Call for Applications - 2025-2026 Municipal Capital Works**

The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure is inviting eligible funding recipients to submit applications for its 2025-2026 infrastructure funding programs.

**The Call for Applications will open October 30, and close November 29, 2024.**

This intake is for the Municipal Capital Works (MCW) provincial funding program, and submitted applications may also be considered for the anticipated joint federal-provincial Canadian Housing Infrastructure Fund (CHIF).

The Application Guide addresses the submittal requirements of the **MCW** application, and program highlights including high level information for CHIF. This Guide, along with other important information can be found on our website at:

Applicants must submit all required submissions, as outlined in the Application Guide, by the deadline. MI may reject late or incomplete applications.

Important considerations to note:

**1. Application Categories of Interest**

While Applicants may submit applications for any of the eligible infrastructure categories, applications that suitably address existing Boil Water Advisories, compliance with Federal Wastewater Systems Effluent Regulations, or the impacts of climate change are of particular interest.

**2. CHIF Program Parameters are under development**

TI is currently working with Canada to finalize the CHIF program parameters. TI anticipates that CHIF will support Water, Wastewater, and Storm water projects. TI will reach out to applicants in the late fall or early winter period to fill any information gaps identified. More information can be found at:

**3. MYCW Funding Recipients Ineligible for MCW**

A reminder that municipalities who receive Multi-Year Capital Works (MYCW) funding from TI are ineligible for MCW. That said, MYCW recipients who have applications potentially eligible for CHIF may submit during this Open Call.
