Construction Schedule and Asphalt Patching

- 1. If the project start date required is different than SGC 11.2 "Except for SGC 11.1 and, unless otherwise specified or approved by the Engineer, the Contractor shall be mobilized and on the work site within 14 days after notification, in writing, of the acceptance of his tender," then it should be specified in the tender document in an addendum as the "Construction Schedule". For example: if a project is tendered in October but the owner does not want it started until the following spring; or, if there are certain items of work which the owner requires to be completed first or in a particular order, it should be specified in the "Construction Schedule".
- In the April, 2003 revision of the Master Spec article 02574.1.1.5 will be deleted. You are advised that if theoretical patching is greater than 1/3 of the asphalt surface area patching should not be specified. Complete removal of asphalt and new asphalt paving should be specified.
