**Re:** Update to Procurement Thresholds

**Date:** February 8, 2024

The Municipal Infrastructure Division (MI) would like to advise communities throughout the Province that the Public Procurement Agency (PPA) has revised the Public Procurement Policy, effective January 1, 2024.

PPA has increased the Open Call for Bids thresholds (excluding HST) as shown below:

Public Bodies	Thresholds			
	Goods	Services	Public Works	Lease of Space
Departments	\$33,400	\$133,800	\$133,800	\$100,000
MASH*	\$133,800	\$133,800	\$334,400	\$100,000
Crown Corporations	\$264,200	\$264,200	\$264,200	\$100,000
*Municipalities, Local Service Districts, Academic Institutions, School Districts, Health Authorities				

This means that an Open Call for Bids is not strictly required for goods/services/public works below the threshold, depending on whether or not other exceptions apply. Please refer to PPA’s Public Procurement Policy, available here: <https://www.gov.nl.ca/ppa/division/legislation/>
