Re: Waste Management Committee Meeting
Date: March 4, 2014

As you are aware, the Provincial Solid Waste Management Strategy requires the closure of all unlined landfills in the province. As a follow-up to our meeting of February 18, 2014, in Springdale, a meeting is scheduled for 6:00pm, March 11 at the Green Bay Waste Building in South Brook. It is requested that the Green Bay Waste Committee meet with representatives from the Department of Municipal and Intergovernmental Affairs to discuss the formation of a regional committee.

This regional committee will provide guidance in the development of a Request for Proposals to obtain a consultant to carry out a study of the requirements for the Baie Verte-Green Bay waste management system. It will also oversee the ultimate implementation of the consultant's recommendations. The study will investigate infrastructure needs, such as, transfer stations, waste recovery facilities and collection/transportation models, and will provide projected operational costs for the system as well as the governance structure for the Regional Service Board.
